
Donor Opportunities for the Palacios Coastal Pavilion



The rebuilding of the landmark Palacios Pavilion was conceived long before the remaining structure was demolished and removed in 2011. Roberta Ripke, then Executive Director of the Palacios Area Fund, worked diligently with many dedicated citizens to ensure that the Palacios Coastal Pavilion was the recipient of a portion of Matagorda County's Coastal Impact Assistance Program grants, which ultimately totaled \$1,004,327. Since then, many additional contributions and major grants have been dedicated to complete the project.


In 2012, the City of Palacios accepted ownership of the Pavilion and agreed to work with the Palacios Beautification Committee, Inc., a 501c3 charitable organization formed in 2000 for the betterment of the Palacios community, to develop the project. In May 2013, the team of Randall-Porterfield Architects, Inc. (League City) and Urban Engineering (Victoria) was chosen to design a unique structure and guide construction. Permanent exhibits will include mobile educational kiosks inside the Pavilion, as well as interchangeable photo displays of the area's natural resources and its history. Interpretive signage will be installed along the ramp, walks and plazas to stimulate discovery of local flora and fauna and to further share the history of our coastline.

Collaborations on events and coastal education will include local and regional non-profit organizations such as Palacios Yacht Club, Palacios Visual Artists Club, Palacios Chamber of Commerce, Palacios HUB and Matagorda County Convention & Visitors Bureau, as well as educational partnerships with PISD, Texas A&M Sea Grant College, Wharton County Junior College STEM Program and Texas Parks & Wildlife Department. The future is bright for this landmark attraction to become an enjoyable amenity for the community, a coastal educational destination and a unique attraction for visitors to the city.



All major gifts to the Palacios Pavilion will be recognized in the Pavilion. Those underwriting the larger costs of building the Pavilion are featured on shells beneath the Giving Tree. Donations of \$500 to \$4999 will be honored on the leaves of the Tree. All contributors donating at the Naming Opportunities level will be featured on plaques bordering the Giving Tree.
